**Reading:**

An endangered species is an animal or a plant that is very likely to become extinct soon. There are almost 28 000 animals and plants in danger of extinction on the Red List of Threatened Species and the number is increasing rapidly. What is dangerous for various species is the destruction of their habitats, climate change and poaching for ivory, fur, etc... For some species like dinosaurs or mammoths, the time on our planet has already run out. But there are some that can be saved if we make a little effort to protect them.

The rarest animal on Earth at the moment is probably amur leopard. Its fur is the beautiful spotted fur it is killed for. There are only about 50 living individuals left in the wild. The second rarest are gorillas – there are just over 200 cross river gorillas in the wild and about 600 mountain gorillas. The cause of such a dramatic situation is people's greed for land and money – they cut down the trees that are gorillas' shelter, or they kill the big monkeys for fun or meat. A sea turtle is also close to being extinct as it has lost almost 90% of its population in the past 10 years. Number four on the list is the orangutan classified as critically endangered with not more than 6600 remaining orangutans on Sumatra. Thanks to extensive deforestation the critical number has also been reached by the Sumatran elephant. Only about 2000 of them have survived. The elephants are usually killed for ivory. There are also species on the list so rare that they have been discovered recently - the example is Saola, a big mammal discovered in Vietnam about 30 years ago. Tigers and rhinos that we all well know from the zoos might also disappear soon if we don't do anything to save them – three of the nine tiger subspecies and three of the five rhino subspecies are already extinct. There are less than 500 Sumatran tigers and only 50 Sumatran rhinos in the wild!

We have already lost so many interesting creatures in the past, for example the aurochs, a large wild cattle that lived in Europe, Asia and North Africa, that we should look for ways of saving the animals if we want a beautiful and versatile world for our children. [source: onekindplanet.org]
