Do know who the most famous Canadian celebrity is? It's Justin Bieber, a 24-year-old pop star – a singer and a songwriter. He is 1.75 m tall. He has got brown eyes, blond hair, many tattoos and millions of fans all over the world.

Justin was born on 1st March, 1994. He grew up in a small town of Stratford in Canada with a single mum. His dad left when he was little, but appeared in Bieber's life when Justin became famous. His grandparents were Polish emigrants.

Justin was always into music, he liked playing instruments and singing. He entered a local talent show at the age of 12 and won the second prize. His mum recorded Justin singing covers and downloaded the videos on YouTube. After a few months he had many followers and gained popularity. A man from a record company phoned Justin and invited him to the USA to sign a contract. That's how his career began.

He released five albums. His first album "My world" with his first big hit "Baby" went platinum in many countries in 2009. He soon had four singles on the Top 40.

The second album "My world 2.0" gave 10 new songs to his fans in 2010. Later he released a film "Never say never" and an album "Under the mistletoe" in 2011. Then he recorded "Believe" in 2012 and "Purpose" in 2015 with his biggest hits "What do you mean?", "Sorry" and "Love yourself". He sold over 140 million records by the end of 2017 and reached 100 million followers on Twitter.

In 2010 and 2012 he won an American Music Award for the Artist of the Year and is one of the most powerful celebrities in the world. [adapted from wikipedia.com]
