**Reading:**

Albert Einstein was one of the most famous scientists of all time. He was a German physicist who developed the theory of relativity. He is best known for his  $E = mc^2$  formula. He got the 1921 Nobel Prize in Physics.

Albert Einstein was born on 14th March 1879 in Ulm, Germany. He went to Catholic elementary school in Munich. Because of some business problems Einstein's family moved to Italy, but the young Albert stayed in Germany to finish his education. He joined his family in Italy in 1894. He wanted to study on Polytechnic in Zürich at the age of 16, so he took the entrance exams, but he failed. On the advice of the principal of the Polytechnic, he completed his secondary education in a gymnasium in Switzerland. In 1896, he passed the Swiss Matura with mostly good grades, including 6 in Physics and Maths. At 17, he started a four-year teaching program and in 1900 he got his teaching diploma.

Einstein was married twice. He had three children with his first wife Marić. They had a daughter and two sons Hans Albert and Eduard. They divorced in 1919 and he married his cousin Elsa the same year. They emigrated to the United States in 1933, where she died of a heart and kidney problems.

From 1908 he started his career at universities in many parts of the world. His popularity in the world of science gave him opportunity to travel around the world with his lectures. He was invited to New York City, London, Singapore, Ceylon and Japan, Spain and Palestine.

Next to science Einstein loved and appreciated music. He started playing the violin at the age of five. He loved Mozart's music a lot.

He died in hospital on 18th April 1955 at the age of 76 from internal bleeding.

Throughout his life, Einstein published hundreds of books and articles. He published more than 300 scientific papers and 150 non-scientific ones. His intellectual achievements and originality have made the word "Einstein" synonymous with "genius". [adapted from en.wikipedia.org]
