What is the Arctic and where is it? Let's learn some facts about this part of the world.

The Arctic is in the north of our planet around the North Pole. It's in the north of Canada, Russia, the USA, Greenland, Norway, Finland, Sweden and Iceland. In the centre of the Arctic there is the Arctic Ocean covered with ice. The ice of the Arctic keeps a lot of fresh water. There are no trees on land - only small plants and grass.

The Arctic is freezing cold with temperature of up to -70°C. It is also very dark in winter months. In December there is a 24-hour night and in June a 24-hour day.

It is a very unfriendly part of the world, but four million people live there. They know how to survive in the cold. They build unusual houses, igloos. A family of two to twenty people can live in an igloo. Some people live in special tents made of animal skin and driftwood or bones. There are many groups of people that live in the Arctic, and some of them are called the Inuits, Chukchi or Nenets. They have got their own language and culture. They eat fish, seals or whales and wear clothes made of animal skins.

It is also a place where many beautiful animals live on land or in the sea, for example: polar bears, Arctic foxes, walruses, seals, whales, narwhals and many kinds of fish and birds. They also love this unfriendly land and let's hope they will survive the climate change.
