Yellowstone National Park is a very big area in the USA. It's in three states: Wyoming, Montana and Idaho. It is the first national park in the world and it's almost 150 years old. There are many hot springs, mud volcanoes, about 290 waterfalls and 500 geysers. There is a very famous geyser called Old Faithful that shoots the water every 90 minutes. In the park there is a river called Yellowstone and a Yellowstone Lake. The river is in a canyon. It's very beautiful. There is also a super volcano under the park.

Yellowstone is wild. There are high mountains, forests, rivers and lakes. It is home for many big mammals. You can see a grey wolf, a grizzly bear, a Canadian lynx, a baribal, a wapiti, a moose, an elk, a coyote or a cougar there. It's the only place where you can see a wild American bison. There are many birds as well, for example an eagle, an owl or a raven and many fish in the river.

You can visit the park in spring, summer and autumn. Summers in the park are usually hot. The temperatures are above 20 degrees Celsius. In winter it's very cold, so it is closed.


